

The University of Auckland Alumni Photography Competition

Terms and conditions

Term

The University of Auckland Alumni Photography Competition (the “Competition”) begins at midnight October 1 and finishes at 12 noon on October 27 NZ time.

Theme

The theme of the Competition is ‘the expression of who we are’

Who May Enter

All graduates (up to and including Spring 2009 graduates) of The University of Auckland are eligible to enter. Members of the judging panel and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the Competition.

How to Enter

For your entry to be valid you must email your photographs to alumniphotocomp@gmail.com by 12 noon on October 27 (NZ time). The body of the email, must contain the following information:

First name
Surname
Student ID (if known)
Contact telephone number
Caption (please provide a caption for each photo submitted)

(“Entry”)

Note: Emails and submitted photographs will not be returned. You are advised to keep a copy of all files submitted.

By submitting an entry you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions and warrant that your entry complies with all of the terms and conditions of the Competition.

The University reserves the right to disqualify any entry which does not comply with these terms and conditions. Winners who are disqualified are required to return prizes and will have their names removed from the list of winners and shortlisted entries.

Number of entries

You may submit up to 3 Entries. Any entrant exceeding the maximum number of entries will be disqualified from the competition.

Entry requirements

Photographs must be in digital format. The photograph need not be taken with a digital camera; scans of negatives, transparencies, or photographic prints are acceptable. All digital files must be 5 megabytes or smaller, must be in JPEG or JPG format, and must be at least 1,600 pixels wide if a horizontal image (landscape) or 1,600 pixels tall if a vertical image (portrait).

Photographs must have been taken within twelve months of the date of entry

You are solely responsible for ensuring that your photographs do not infringe any copyright.

Every photograph submitted must be a single original work taken by you.

Release

By entering the Competition you undertake to ensure that each identifiable person appearing in the photograph is aware of and agrees to the publication of the photograph by The University of Auckland for a period of 2 years following the announcement of the winners.

Contest prizes

1st: Nikon D5000 D-SLR camera

2nd: A photography course from The Centre for Continuing Education, up to a value of \$200*

3rd: A selection of photography books from the University Book Store, worth \$100

*If the 2nd prize winner is unable to attend the course in Auckland, an alternative prize of equal monetary value will be selected by the Alumni Office

Judging

1. The overall quality of the submitted photographs will be given primary consideration in the selection of winners
2. Relevance to the theme, and the level of creativity used to illustrate the theme will also be taken into consideration.

There are three rounds of judging in this competition:

- Round one – shortlisting: The judges will meet to review all entries and create a shortlist
- Round two – scoring: The judges will individually score each entry
- Round three – selecting winners: The judges will meet to discuss those entries with a high combined score, and will select the three winners.

Decisions of the judges are final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.

License

You retain copyright in your photographs however by entering the Competition, you grant The University of Auckland the right to publish no later than 1 November 2011 the photograph or arrange publication in books, brochures and on its websites and other publications in any form or media worldwide. All publications featuring the photograph will include the name of the photographer.

Limitation of Liability

By entering this Competition you agree to release, discharge, and hold harmless The University of Auckland and University employees from any claims, losses, and damages arising out of your participation in this Competition or any Competition-related activities and the acceptance and use, misuse, or possession of any prize awarded hereunder.
